# Summary Report

Geography: 5 Miles

## Population

In 2006, the population in your selected geography is 148,604. The population has changed by 15.76% since 2000. It is estimated that the population in your area will be 164,434 five years from now, which represents a change of 10.65% from the current year. The current population is 47.31% male and 52.69% female. The median age of the population in your area is 45.3, compare this to the US average which is 36.5. The population density in your area is 1,892.09 people per square mile.

## Households

There are currently 66,745 households in your selected geography. The number of households has changed by 16.05% since 2000. It is estimated that the number of households in your area will be 74,273 five years from now, which represents a change of 11.28% from the current year. The average household size in your area is 2.19 persons.

## Income

In 2006, the median household income for your selected geography is \$35,833, compare this to the US average which is currently \$48,271. The median household income for your area has changed by 12.45% since 2000. It is estimated that the median household income in your area will be \$38,778 five years from now, which represents a change of 8.22% from the current year.

The current year per capita income in your area is \$21,446, compare this to the US average, which is \$24,529. The current year average household income in your area is \$46,197, compare this to the US average which is \$63,629.

## Race & Ethnicity

The current year racial makeup of your selected area is as follows: 95.14% White, 1.19% Black, 0.25% Native American and 1.35% Asian/Pacific Islander. Compare these to US averages which are: 75.86% White, 12.07% Black, 0.71% Native American and 4.51% Asian/Pacific Islander.

People of Hispanic origin are counted independently of race. People of Hispanic origin make up 6.16% of the current year population in your selected area. Compare this to the US average of 14.94%.

## Housing

The median housing value in your area was \$70,552 in 2000, compare this to the US average of \$115,194 for the same year. In 2000, there were 46,262 owner occupied housing units in your area and there were 11,251 renter occupied housing units in your area. The median rent at the time was \$458.

## Employment

In 2006, there are 36,897 employees in your selected area, this is also known as the daytime population. The 2000 Census revealed that 58.9% of employees are employed in white-collar occupations in this geography, and 41.1% are employed in blue-collar occupations. In 2006, unemployment in this area is 4.59%. In 2000, the median time traveled to work was 22.9 minutes.

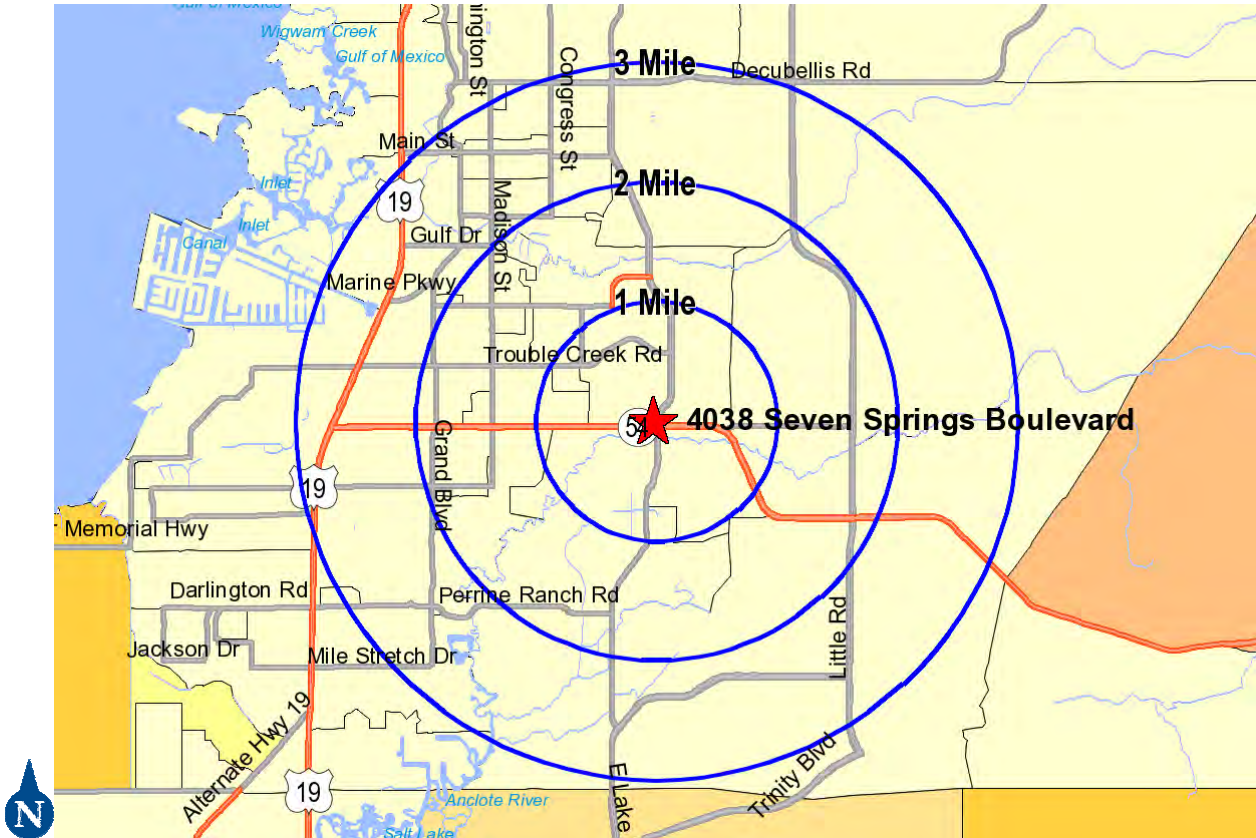

Number of people living in a given area per square mile.



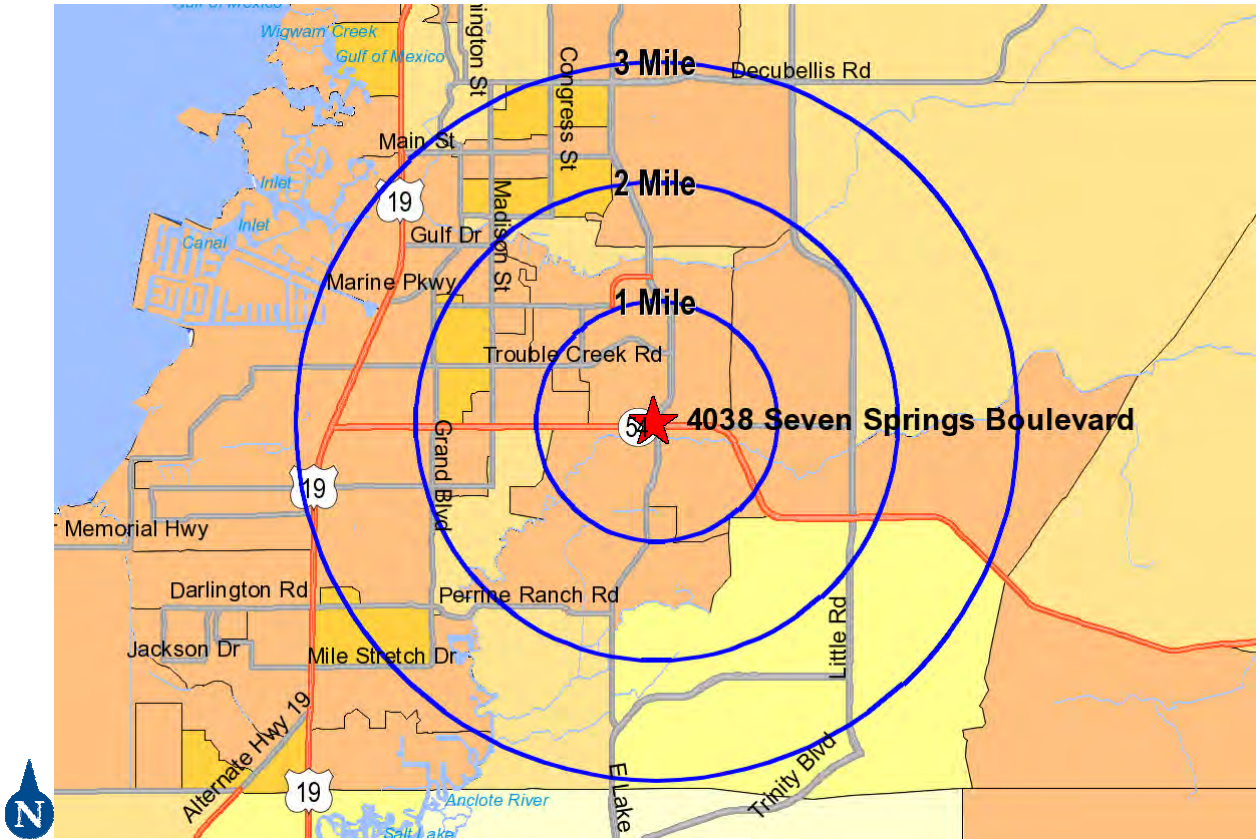

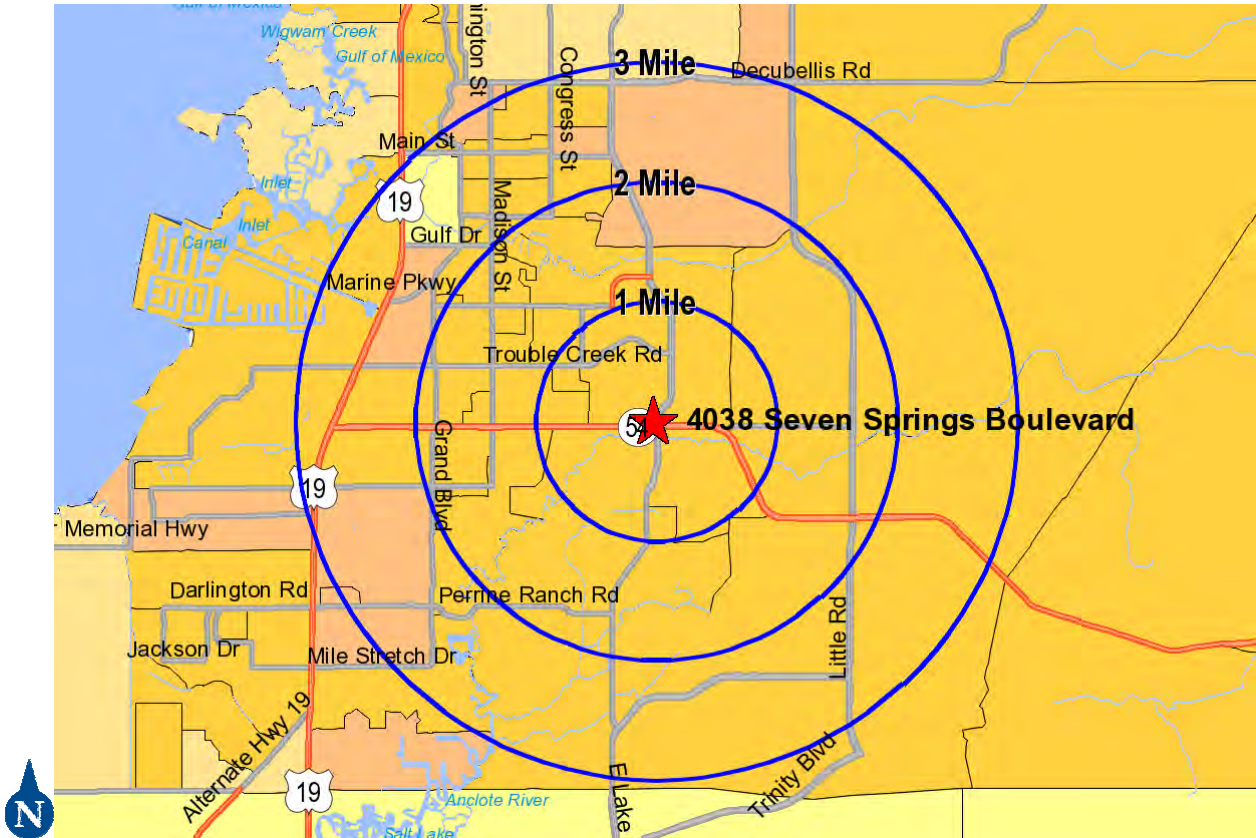

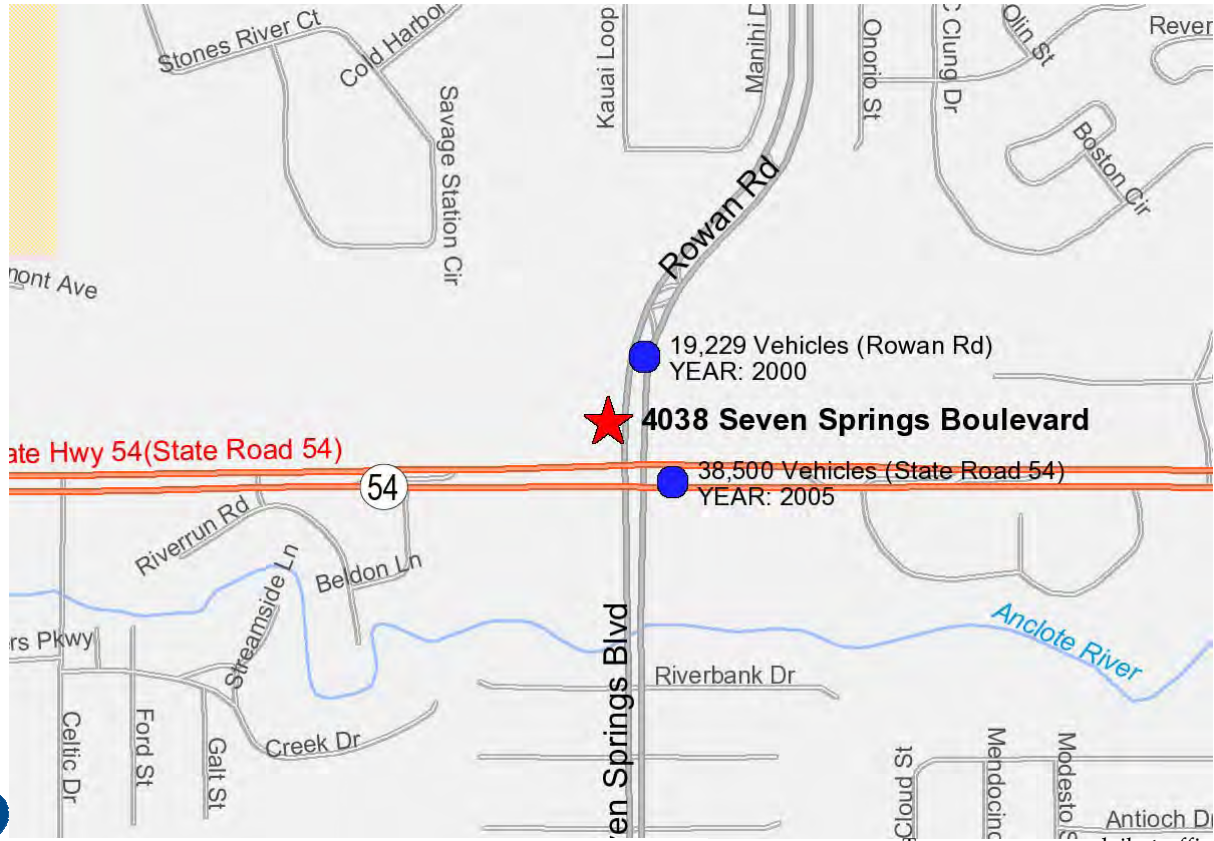
